CIRANO, Tuesday, January 12, 2016 from 11 am until 1:30 pm

► Processus d'appels d'offres relatif à l'approvisionnement en médicaments au sein des centres hospitaliers du Québec CIRANO, Wednesday January 27, 2016 from noon until 1:15 pm

Me Mélanie Bourassa Forcier, Associate Professor at the Faculty of Law of the University of Sherbrooke and a Fellow at CIRANO, will give a conference entitled "Processus d'appels d'offres relatif à l'approvisionnement en médicaments au sein des centres hospitaliers du Québec", on Wednesday January 27, 2016 at noon, at CIRANO..

During the spring of 2014, the Auditor General of Quebec highlighted the costs of pharmaceutical products and services and underlined questionable practices of health facilities. In their report, the authors Mélanie Bourassa Forcier and Alexandra Foucher explain the pharmaceutical products supply process of healthcare providers in the province of Quebec and, more precisely, the tendering and bidding process launched by the procurement group, for Quebecers to better understand and, more importantly, to be able to evaluate the advantages and disadvantages of the process. Achieving this objective is all the more relevant considering the current discussions regarding the extension of the tendering system in the ambulatory setting.

The Governor General of Canada announced on December 30th the appointment of Marcel Boyer as Officer to the Order of Canada for his contributions to economics, notably as the co-founder of CIRANO.
